Eligibility:

- Must be a US Citizen
- Must be a Wyoming Resident
- Must attend a college or trade school within Wyoming
- Be a full-time student
- Carry a 2.0 or higher GPA

***Please note, a higher priority will be given to applicants whose parent or relative are a Wyoming Ground Water Association member, which must be a member for three consecutive years. ***

Requirements:

- WGWA Scholarship application. **MUST BE FILLED OUT COMPLETELY!**
- Most current transcript. *(Only transcripts from your school will be accepted.)*
- Two letters of recommendation. *(The following are acceptable: high school teacher, college professor, counselor, employer, community leader, adult mentor, etc. The letter cannot be from a family member.)*
- 300 to 500-word essay
- Photograph *(will not be returned)*
 - *Recipients, if chosen, must also submit a thank-you video*

Recipients of the WGWA Scholarship will be notified by May 1, 2026.

Up to 7-\$2,500 scholarships will be awarded.
